## General Safety Instructions (GPSR)

Improper cleaning can not only compromise the hygiene and function of your baby bottle, but also **endanger your baby's health and safety.**

- The baby bottle must be used exclusively **for feeding babies.**
- Use the bottle only **under adult supervision.**
- The bottle is **not a toy**—keep it out of reach of children at all times when not in use.
- Check the bottle for damage before each use (e.g., cracks in the glass or defective seals).
- Do not continue to use the bottle if damage is visible.
- Always check the **temperature of the food** before feeding (**wrist test**).
- Glass can **be damaged by impacts or falls** – handle it with care.
- Do not expose the bottle to extreme temperature shocks (e.g., directly from the refrigerator into boiling water).
- Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents—these can damage the material and surface.
- All components must be clean and completely dry before each use.
- Individual parts (e.g., nipple, cap, seals) must be properly assembled to prevent leaks

## Important safety note regarding glass bottles

### **Glass bottles are not suitable for use by children without adult supervision!**

Even high-quality borosilicate glass is **not shatterproof**. The glass bottle may break if dropped, knocked, subjected to strong pressure, or comes into contact with hard surfaces. This can result in **sharp shards** that may cause **cuts, bleeding, and serious injuries.**

Glass bottles should therefore only be used by adults or under the direct supervision of an adult.

Please note:

- **Never** leave glass bottles **unattended in the hands of children.**
- **Do not** place glass bottles **in a playpen, crib, car seat, or stroller** for independent use.
- Do not use the glass bottle if your child could hold it themselves, drop it, or bite it.
- Avoid **bumps, knocks, strong pressure, or contact with hard surfaces.**
- **Carefully** inspect the glass bottle **for cracks, chips, or other damage** before each use.

- Do not **continue** to use damaged glass bottles **under any circumstances**.
- Dispose of **damaged glass bottles immediately and safely** to prevent any risk of injury.

For children who are already drinking independently, we strongly recommend shatterproof alternatives such as plastic bottles, sippy cups, or spouted cups.

### Why LIINI® bottle nipples may leak slightly when held “upside down”

It is completely normal and a deliberate design feature that our bottle nipples may leak slightly when the bottle is tilted sharply or turned upside down.

The reason for this lies in the design—and directly serves your baby’s safety and healthy development. The teats are designed so that your baby has to actively suck—similar to breastfeeding. A completely leak-proof nipple would often create too much negative pressure or unnaturally alter the flow of liquid.

A minimal air exchange is important so that:

- your baby can drink evenly
- excessive negative pressure does not build up
- the risk of colic, gas, and discomfort is reduced

### Protection against “overfeeding”

If milk can flow out with light pressure or due to gravity, this prevents your baby from passively “overflowing.” Your baby retains control over the flow of milk—this is important for a healthy sense of fullness.

### Replace bottle nipples regularly

LIINI® bottle nipples must be replaced regularly to ensure your baby’s hygiene, safety, and health. Teats are subject to natural wear and tear from sucking, biting, cleaning, sterilization, and daily use. Over time, they can become brittle, tear, discolor, or develop minor material damage.

As a general rule:

- Replace bottle nipples **at least every 1-2 months**.
- Replace the nipple immediately if cracks, holes, discoloration, sticky spots, deformations, or other damage are visible.
- Gently pull on the nipple before each use and carefully inspect it for wear.
- Never continue to use damaged nipples.
- Replace teats more frequently with heavy use.
- **Replace teats after your baby has been sick** for hygiene reasons.

Regular inspection and timely replacement are important to minimize the risk of choking, material detachment, bacterial growth, and hygiene issues.

### Not suitable for sterilizers or dishwashers

The LIINI® double-walled baby bottle is not suitable for cleaning in a sterilizer or dishwasher. The reason for this is the special double-glass construction: there is a small hole at the bottom of the outer glass. This is technically necessary to allow for pressure equalization in the space between the two glass layers.

Sterilizers, dishwashers, steam, high water pressure, or prolonged immersion can cause water or moisture to enter the space between the two glass layers through this hole. This can lead to moisture buildup, limescale deposits, discoloration, staining, or hygiene issues.

Please note:

- **Do not clean** double-walled bottles **in a sterilizer.**
- **Do not clean** double-walled bottles **in the dishwasher.**
- Do not fully submerge the bottle in water.
- Do not use steam cleaning.
- Clean only by hand with warm water, mild dish soap, and a soft bottle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly after cleaning and allow to air dry completely.

Cleaning in a sterilizer, dishwasher, or improper cleaning may impair the function, hygiene, and longevity of the double-walled glass bottle. In such cases, all warranty and guarantee claims are excluded.

### General Cleaning Instructions

#### Before first use

- Thoroughly clean all parts with warm water and mild dish soap.
- Then rinse all components carefully.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely.

- Use a soft bottle brush if necessary.
- Rinse all parts thoroughly with clean water.
- Let all components dry completely before reassembling them.
